FULL POOL...

It is our prediction that the lake will reach levels that have not been seen in the past. We have been working diligently to overcome the obstacles this will put us against. Today we lost our public launch ramp because of the high water level. We are currently completing a one lane launch ramp near the four lane marina ramp. The lake is still coming up 1' every sixty hours. We estimate this one lane ramp should be operational by the end of February.

Boaters beware; there is an abundant amount of debris floating all around the lake. It has cleared up tremendously of late. We are doing what we can to clear the large logs and trees from the marina. It will take some time for everything to clear up, especially with the continued rising levels. In the meantime we suggest turning off your marine air systems so they do not clog your cooling/heating systems.
