We still would like to remind those that haven't provided us with the following to do so ASAP. A big thank you goes out to all that have already sent in your information.

- Water Craft Documentation: AZ Registration or Coast Guard Reg.
- Current Proof of Insurance with RLM listed as an additionally insured, interested party or a certificate holder. (\$300,000 in minimum liability coverage is required)
- Trailer Title or Trailer Registration.

Credit Card Payments Over the Phone, "New Procedures"

Some members have been calling us to make payments over the phone by credit card. We have a new form that must be completed and faxed back to us in order to post this type of payment to your account. Give us a call or stop by the office so we can provide one to you.

As an alternative, we highly recommend getting set up on auto credit card billing for your storage bill. But remember, auto pay only pays for your storage bill, not other items charged to your account. Contact Shirley or Sharon if you have any other questions regarding payment on your account.

SRP Rate Hike...

Salt River Project has again risen the per Kilowatt rate. This is an additional increase with one more to come in the spring. November power usage and forward will now be billed at \$.09 a kWh. Conserve your power usage and save \$\$ even with the higher rates.
